1. INTRODUCTION

YRE Litter Less New Zealand is a national environmental education programme that gives young people the opportunity to be part of the solution by producing creative and engaging environmental journalism. Participants (ages 11-14 and 15-18) investigate and report on environmental issues relating to litter, and propose solutions by using video, photography or writing. The goal of YRE Litter Less is to reduce litter and affect long-term behaviour change among young people. It aims to empower young people to take a stand on environmental issues they feel strongly about and to give them a platform to articulate these issues. The programme offers these enthusiastic young people a chance to make their voices heard and to feel that they are being listened to.
