



# Beautiful Awards 2019

## Terms and Conditions

---

*Updated 10<sup>th</sup> March 2019*

---

**The terms and conditions are as follows:**

1. Information on how to nominate and enter a submission and all details on the entry form are a part of these terms and conditions. To the extent of any inconsistency, the terms and conditions below prevail. By entering, participants accept these terms and conditions.
2. Nominations are open to New Zealand residents only.
3. Anyone employed by (and any immediate family member of someone employed by) Keep New Zealand Beautiful are ineligible to enter.
4. Nominations and submission dates: *open* on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019 and *close* on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2019 and need to be submitted to Keep New Zealand Beautiful via the website Beautiful Awards webform on or before the outlined date.
5. All information, photos, videos and details needs to be supplied as per the category criteria.
6. Entries are valid only for projects, campaigns and initiatives, which have been completed between 1<sup>st</sup> August 2018 and 31<sup>st</sup> July 2019 unless otherwise stipulated in the category criteria.
7. Winners and finalists. One overall winner will be selected for each award. Finalists will be appointed at the judge's discretion for each category.

Towns & Cities judge visits. By entering in the Towns & Cities categories, you acknowledge that, if you are selected as a finalist, you will be required to host the Beautiful Award's judges for half (1/2) a day, in your town or city. Should the judges require accommodation and/or other travel arrangements, such as transport to and from airports, etc, you acknowledge that the submitting council can provide and cover associated costs for this. KNZB will confirm dates with you once you are notified that you are a finalist.



8. Award Categories. There are 15 official awards across five categories:

#### Category 1 - INDIVIDUALS

1. Young Legend Award
2. Tidy Kiwi Award
3. Local Hero Award

#### Category 2 - COMMUNITY

4. Community Environmental Initiative Award, proudly sponsored by Klean Kanteen
5. Community Group Award
6. Sustainable Schools Award

#### Category 3 - BUSINESSES

7. Most Sustainable Business Project
8. Most Sustainable Business Small <20 staff
9. Most Sustainable Business Large > 20 staff

#### Category 4 - PLACES

10. Best Loo, proudly sponsored by Plumbing World
11. Best Street, proudly sponsored by Resene
12. Kiwi's Choice, proudly sponsored by Resene

#### Category 5 - TOWNS & CITIES

13. Most Beautiful Small Town (Minor Urban Area)
14. Most Beautiful Large Town (Secondary Urban Area)
15. Most Beautiful City (Main Urban Area)

9. The judging panel will be made up a variety of representatives from the following fields; Keep New Zealand Beautiful board, education, council/government, community and business sectors.

There will be a different make up of judges for each of the categories to suit the types of awards. Each award will be judged against the official 'Beautiful Awards Criteria' for 2019. If an entry does not meet the requirements outlined in the criteria it will automatically be forfeited from the nominations.

No sponsors or any person with a conflict of interest may be on the judging panel to judge an award or category that they are entering/can enter. However, they are able to judge a category that does not conflict. For example, New Zealand Couriers are the sponsor of the Sustainable Schools Award which is awarded as part of the 'Community Category' - This means they can be a judge for Community Category awards, but they are not eligible to enter to win any of the Community Awards. Yet, they can enter the Business Awards as their sponsorship is not associated with this category, therefore meaning there is no conflict of interest.



The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Prizes cannot be exchanged for cash, credit or service and no exchange communications will be entered into - Where there is a monetary component, payment will be made into the winner's account after the Beautiful Awards Gala Dinner when account details are exchanged.

10. Winners will be announced at the Keep New Zealand Beautiful Awards Gala Dinner held at the Toitu Otago Settlers Museum, Dunedin on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> of October. They will be presented with an award at the awards evening. Finalists will receive a certificate sent the week following the awards.
11. Media, Signage and Promotion. Any mention of an award in the media and/or on signage to promote receiving an award must use the exact wording of the award and acknowledge Keep New Zealand Beautiful and the sponsor (if there is one attached to the specific award). The date of receiving the award needs to be included also.  
  
For example, Dunedin, winner of 2018 Most Beautiful City Award. Presented by Keep New Zealand Beautiful. Any signage created for the town or city needs to be signed off by Keep New Zealand Beautiful for approval.
12. Neither Keep New Zealand Beautiful or associated Sponsors are liable for any loss, damage or injury (including without limitation indirect or consequential loss) suffered by any person in connection with the award or any prize, except for any liability under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 or other liability that cannot be excluded by law.
13. All entries are deemed received at the time of receipt by Keep New Zealand Beautiful and not at time of transmission by the entrant. Keep New Zealand Beautiful records are conclusive as to time of receipt. Late, lost, stolen, misdirected, illegal, incomplete, illegible, damaged, reproduced, or altered entries are invalid. Keep New Zealand Beautiful is not responsible for such entries or for any error, technical malfunction, loss, omission, communications delay or failure.
14. Keep New Zealand Beautiful reserves the right to vary these terms and conditions or to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the promotion.
15. Keep New Zealand Beautiful reserves the right to verify the validity of any entry. Keep New Zealand Beautiful may disqualify any person(s) who enters the competition using the same entry as another participant or for submitting work that has not been undertaken by the nominee.
16. Entries and nominations become the property of Keep New Zealand Beautiful. In accordance with the Privacy Act 1993, Keep New Zealand Beautiful collects and holds personal information to conduct the promotion, notify prize winners, verify prize winners' identities and may be used for



Keep New Zealand Beautiful future promotional activities, including (where consented to) sending the entrant emails and/or text messages. Individuals have rights to access and request correction of their personal information held by Keep New Zealand Beautiful by calling 09 264 1434. Failure to provide all requested personal information may result in the entry being invalid.

Each entrant agrees that, if he or she wins an award, his or her details (including name, suburb/town, and photo and design) may be published by Keep New Zealand Beautiful (for promotion of the awards via all channels. For example, press, print, Facebook, website, Twitter etc.) and used for other publicity purposes.
