Resene Wall Worthy competition terms and conditions are as follows:

1. Information on how to nominate and enter a submission and all details on the entry form are a part of these terms and conditions. To the extent of any inconsistency, the terms and conditions below prevail. By entering, participants accept these terms and conditions.
2. Entries are open to New Zealand residents only.
3. Anyone employed by (and any immediate family member of someone employed by) Keep New Zealand Beautiful are ineligible to enter.
4. Design entries close 27 March 2020 and need to be submitted to Keep New Zealand Beautiful on or before that date. Only one entry per ECE, school or youth group can be entered. If your school, ECE or youth group has multiple classrooms who wish to participate you must run a preliminary in-house judging and put forward your preferred entry as only one entry per organisation will be accepted.
5. Finalists will be announced and will be put for public vote on 31 March 2020. Winners will be notified by 16 April 2020. Murals are to be completed by the end of Term 4, 2020 and must have the Resene and KNZB logos provided on/near the mural.
6. Any murals not completed by the end of Term 1, 2021 will be ineligible to receive the \$500 prize money on completion and a local press release will not be made.
7. The Resene and Keep New Zealand Beautiful logo sticker supplied to you as part of the prize pack must be applied to your mural to be eligible to receive your \$500 prize money on completion.
8. Ten overall winners will be selected across the following categories. Categories outlined by Keep New Zealand Beautiful are as follows: Early Childhood Centres/Kindergartens, Primary/Intermediate Schools, High Schools, Tertiary Institutes and Community/Youth Groups.

10. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 11. Prize cannot be exchanged for cash, credit or service and no exchange communications will be entered into. Winners will receive the \$750 of Resene paint vouchers for the creation of their design within their local community along with drop cloths, hi-vis vests and M&M's.
 12. A photo story/slideshow/video of the process of the mural is required to be created and sent to Keep New Zealand Beautiful on completion of the mural. The winners will then receive their final prize - \$500 prize money upon invoice.
 13. Creation of winning designs must be done so legally by winners, or as organised by winners fitting with correct Health and Safety procedures and supervised at all times.
 14. No spray paint is to be used in creating any Wall Worthy murals.
 15. Prize winners from each category will be notified by email. Should the winner not be able to be contacted by email, contact via phone will be made using contact details submitted at time of entry.
 16. Please ensure your contact details are correct. We will attempt to make contact with all winners by the phone and/or email provided in their entry. If there is no contact made within 14 days, the prize will be awarded to the next runner up.
 17. Neither Keep New Zealand Beautiful or associated sponsors are liable for any loss, damage or injury (including without limitation indirect or consequential loss) suffered by any person in connection with the promotion or any prize, except for any liability under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 or other liability that cannot be excluded by law.
 18. All entries are deemed received at the time of receipt by Keep New Zealand Beautiful and NOT at time of transmission by the entrant. Keep New Zealand Beautiful's records are conclusive as to time of receipt. Late, lost, stolen, misdirected, illegal, incomplete, illegible, damaged, reproduced, or altered entries are invalid.
