



Terms and Conditions

This document forms the terms and conditions for all individuals and groups registering clean up events through Keep New Zealand Beautiful. By registering your event, you and/or your group is agreeing to these terms and conditions.

1. All clean up events are to be registered through the Keep New Zealand Beautiful website. <https://www.knzb.org.nz/help-us/organise-a-clean-up-event/>
2. With the aim of reducing our use of single use plastics, Keep New Zealand Beautiful is no longer encouraging the use of single use resources such as plastic bags and gloves. We encourage volunteers to source their own tools and materials for clean-up events. More information can be found in our Community Clean Up Guide. A limited number of free reusable bags and latex gloves are available upon request.
3. When promoting or advertising your event you must include Keep New Zealand Beautiful as a partner by including the Keep New Zealand Beautiful logo. Examples of your advertising is to be sent to marketing@knzb.org.nz for approval.
4. During your event it is important to ask volunteers to document the litter that is collected and to take photographs as you will need this information to complete your evaluation form. During your event, be sure to also count how many full rubbish bags you collect. Note how many are landfill waste and how many are recycling.
5. You must fill out the online evaluation form no more than 10 business days after your clean up event by completing the form <https://www.knzb.org.nz/programmes/clean-new-zealand-beautiful/community-clean-up-evaluation/> You must answer each question as accurately as possible.
6. If you send us any photos from your event – please ensure that you have gained consent from all people featuring in the photos as all photos submitted may be used by Keep New Zealand Beautiful for the promotion of further clean up initiatives.
7. Ensure the safety of all participants by conducting a Hazard and Risk assessment at the site prior to the clean-up and brief all participants on the day about Health and Safety. Please see the Community Clean Up Guide for more Health and Safety information.
